We have many fun activities and events planned for Catholic Schools Week. This is a time to celebrate Catholic Education and honor Catholic Educators!

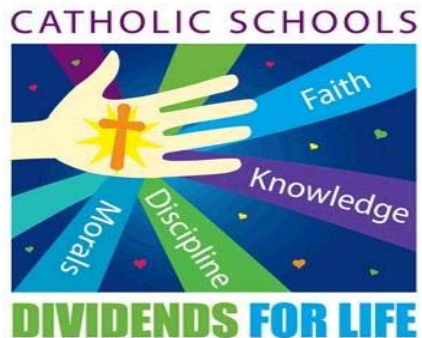

Thursday, 1/28: Closing prayer service, raffle winners have lunch with Principal and Asst. Principal, and Wheel of Wisdom



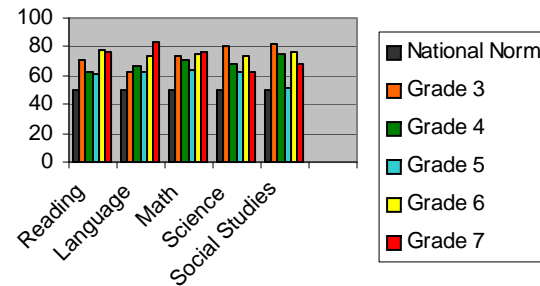
