Religion

Two chapters are left to be taught in the Religion books. In Chapter 26 the students will learn that the Church is one, holy, catholic, and apostolic, that it respects all people, and works for justice and peace. Chapter 28 will focus on three major concepts: that as members of the Church we share in its mission by working for peace and justice; that the seven sacraments are signs of God's presence in our lives; that there are four characteristics that are marks of the Church. This final chapter summarizes what the students have been taught this year. Also, during the month of May we will celebrate Mary, Jesus' mother and ours. The class will read excerpts from the Bible that relate to Mary's life. The Rosary will be reviewed and a decade will be said each morning for prayers. Another group activity will be "An Interview With Mary." Groups will compose questions they'd like to ask Mary. These questions will relate to the Bible stories they've read. Then, with the time left in the school year, we will review.
