During the month of February fourth grade students read primarily the genre of Non-Fiction. Besides reading non-fictional text from their Basal reader, the fourth graders read non-fiction selections from the internet. The topics were based on the Symbols of the USA. Fourth grade students also prepared a table outlining information on the symbol of the USA they chose to read about

and research, and they wrote a paragraph based on the information they compiled on the table they prepared.

In addition they used a pre-reading strategy and became “informational thieves” scanning non-fiction text to build a background of information before they started to read.
