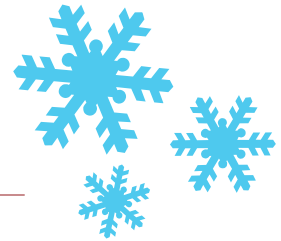

## What We're Reading



The fourth grade students have been reading from the genre of fairytales. The students followed a web quest reading their choice of eight fairytales from a wide variety of titles. While reading, the students kept a reading log to analyze the characters, setting and plot of the fairytales. They used a comparison matrix to analyze the two fairytales according to their characteristics. The students worked with a partner to compare the fairytales, and they used character traits to write a riddle about one character from their readings. Also, they will be working with a partner to write their own fairytale while incorporating three characteristics of fairytales in their writing. In addition, the students will be applying the traits of writing we have been working on throughout this year.
