The letter for last week was "G". The children did such a good job of tracing the letter. The children made goat puppets. They enjoyed using the puppets while I read Three Billy Goats Gruff.

The letter this week was "P". They enjoyed playing a puppy racers game. Of course we read the story The Three Little Pigs. The students made pretzels out of playdoh and enjoyed eating real pretzels. They painted pockets on which they counted and glued pencils onto the pockets. Not a letter can go by where we don't go on our letter hunt. They enjoy the movement and singing. They are awesome at spotting those letters.

In Religion we read a story about our families and how they care for us. We discussed how we can care for others. Ask your child what he/she said they would do to care for you at home.

Some children know how to write their first names. We have been working on correct letter formation with those children. We are also beginning to work on writing the first letter of each child's name.
