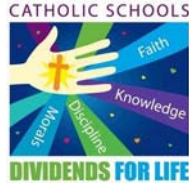


Three Year Old Preschool News January 28, 2010



The letter of the week was "R". The children enjoyed sponge painting their raccoons. We also ran a relay race at school.

The Pre-K students are beginning to learn basic scissor skills. When working on cutting at home, please have your child cut with the thumb up while holding the paper in the other hand. They are all doing very well with this skill. You'll notice in the future some work coming home that he/she has cut on his own.

The children listened to the creation story. As Jesus created the plants, animals, etc He looked at what He created and said, "It is good." When God created people, He looked and said, "It is **very** good." They learned how special each of them are and how much God loves them. The students worked on their first picture of themselves. Remembering all the facial features at this age is still a work in progress. It's such fun to see how their perception of themselves changes as they grow.

Daily counting to ten continues. The children used hop scotch squares to recognize the numbers and walk/hop on the numbers as they count. They also enjoyed working on the activiboard to identify numbers, count, and move bears for the corresponding number.
