The letter of the week was "D". The students used their scissor skills to cut out a door. We read a book about dinosaurs and discussed some different dinosaurs and what they ate.

The children are beginning to learn some position words. Our first set of position words was open/closed. The children went on a walk around the school to identify which doors were open and which were closed. We also used this walk to record the amounts with tally marks and counted the number of doors when we returned to our classroom. The Pre-K students used this idea to make a door that they opened and closed.

The students continue practicing counting to ten. We practice counting by physically separating the counted objects from the others. They enjoyed some delicious counting of M&Ms. They counted to ten with their M&Ms and ate their treat as a reward for their hard work. Who knew Math could be so yummy!

Nurse Mary Ann came in to visit with the Pre-K class and teach the students about dental health. They watched a short video and learned how to brush their teeth. They all received a new toothbrush for their good behavior. We are so lucky to have her at school everyday.
