The letter of week for last week was "B". The children made beautiful bees. They used their scissor skills in cutting out the bee by themselves. What "busy bees" they were that day.

The letter of the week this week was "K". We practiced our kicks and discussed the "K" sounds at the beginning and end of the word. The Pre-K students painted a kite. We will go outside and fly a kite when the weather permits.

The children have been introduced to the word and meaning of Lent. We will only briefly discuss Jesus' dying on the cross, but will focus on Jesus' Resurrection on Easter Sunday. We are practicing doing kind deeds for Jesus during this special time of year. The students made a Lenten cross with tissue paper. They are beautiful!

The shapes are being introduced. The first shape is circle. The children were on a hunt for colored circles in our classroom. This activity was a good review of colors and introduction to the circle shape. We also played a shape memory game on the activboard.

We continue to count to 10. We traveled around the school with our pointer taking turns counting to 10. Lockers, students, projects, and chairs were only some of the objects that were counted. All students received a turn with the pointer to count to ten. (It's very exciting to do anything with the pointer!)
