The children have worked very hard to learn the story of Easter. I have kept the concept very basic for the children. They have been introduced to Jesus all year. They have learned that Jesus died on a cross and came back to life to be with His friends. They know that this happened so we may all go to Heaven one day.

The Pre-K students each made a cave like the one in the Easter story. They created similar events from the story to go with the cave to help remember some of the special events celebrated during Holy Week.
