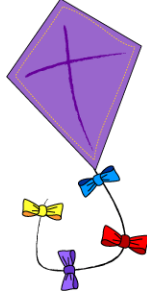


Three Year Old Preschool News May 13, 2010



Last week's letter was "Y". The children went on their letter "Y" hunt. They made "Y" out of playdoh.

This week's letter is "Z". The students colored and glued to make zipper puppets. We read a story about zebras.

Fine motor skills are continuously reinforced. The children used stringing beads and lacing cards for practice. I am thrilled with the Pre-K students' growth in these skills. Their coloring and pencil grip has improved greatly.

The children and I discussed the things we like best about our families. They then prayed with me and thanked God for the special people in their family. It was very touching to hear the children pray for each of you.

The color purple is our new color. We experimented with paint to decide what two colors make purple. After some trial and error, the children decided that blue and red make purple. They each had a turn to mix the colors to make purple and used it to paint flower pictures.

Most of the children are capable of counting to 10. They practiced their counting with connecting links. After counting to 10, they enjoyed connecting their links to other's links in the class. We then made a long chain. We all had fun jumping over the chain as others wiggled it on the ground. Hopscotch squares were also used for students to hop and count to ten.
