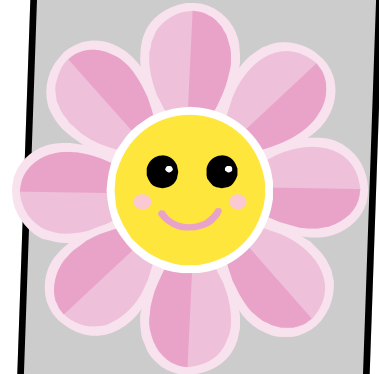
Sixth Grade Homeroom In The News Religion
