Here are some tips to stay safe this summer:

- ~ **Never travel in secluded areas, especially alone**
- ~ **Know where safe places are i.e.: police stations, fire houses, grocery stores etc. (places where there are a lot of people and they can get help if needed)**
- ~ **Only go to houses of people you know**
- ~ **Never accept a ride from someone you don't know**
- ~ **Trust your instincts, if a person or situation makes you uncomfortable, GET OUT OF THERE!**
- ~ **Most importantly, ALWAYS BE AWARE OF YOUR SURROUNDINGS!!!**
